REQUIREMENTS AFTER TURNING IN APPLICATION

*These requirements must be met in order for a student to be enrolled in Band.

- 1. Parent/Guardian <u>must attend</u> the Band Info Meeting on 5/21 at 6:30PM in the WPMS Band Room. Enter through the back of school/Lyons Ave. Entrance.
 - The meeting goes over our Band Handbook, FAQs, how band works with athletics, explains instrument rentals/purchases, explains financial aid, and explains our Booster Organization. This is also when we will answer specific questions and meet our new band students/families!
 - If a parent cannot attend the meeting, they must email the directors to set up an individual meeting by <u>no later than May 30th.</u> Students will not be admitted to band without the directors speaking with the parents, in-person, first.
- 2. The band directors will complete "instrument testing" with each student. We will do this in late May, during the school day, at DEN and McGill. This information is used to guide student/parent in their instrument rental, and is necessary for WPMS to enroll them in the correct band class. Any homeschool students entering the program will need to email the directors to set up a testing appointment.
- 3. Students and Parents must sign and return a completed Band Handbook Contract to the Band Directors by May 30th. This can be done at the 5/21 Info Meeting, where we will go over our handbook.
- 4. Students must secure an <u>acceptable instrument</u> and accessories. Please do not purchase or rent an instrument without speaking with the directors first. The directors will provide easy options for purchase, rental, and need-based financial assistance at the 5/21 meeting or by appointment. Sub-standard equipment will not be allowed in the classroom because of its negative impact on student learning and instructional time. Please let the directors help guide you in obtaining quality, affordable equipment.
- 5. All students must complete a White Pine Middle School Code of Conduct Contract and complete a Drug Test at the beginning of the 2024-2025 School Year. Drug Tests will be completed during the first two weeks of school. Students cannot travel or participate in band without completing a drug test.
